Overview

- **Claims Submission**

- Providers may submit claims electronically (EDI) or continue to submit on paper
- Electronic claims will only be accepted in the ANSI X12N format!

- **Benefits of EDI**

- Timely receipt of claims
- Accurate Data Entry; better record keeping/tracking
- Prevent Duplicate Claims
- Improved Customer Service Quality

- **Financial Considerations**

- Claim payments will continue to be made according to existing contract
- HCD is meeting legal responsibility by implementing the infrastructure to accept and process your electronic files
- HCD is not responsible for Provider costs related to producing and transmitting electronic claims

 - 834 Benefit Enrollment and Maintenance
 - 270 Healthcare Eligibility/Benefit Inquiry
 - 271 Healthcare Eligibility/Benefit Response
 - 835 Healthcare Claim Payment/Advice
 - 276 Healthcare Claim Status Inquiry
 - 277 Healthcare Claim Status Response
 - 278 Healthcare Referral Certification/Authorization/Service Review

What We Are Doing To Prepare

- Assembled an EDI Implementation Team
- Major investment to upgrade our Claims management system
- Offering assistance/outreach to our Provider Network
- Contracting with external resources
 - Vendor work groups
 - Consulting
 - Clearing Houses

What You Need From Us

- Our strong commitment to maximizing EDI capability - Claims EDI will be implemented without disruption or decrease in the level of services provided by HCD

- Required File Formats and Data Elements
 - ANSI 837 Professional and Institutional
 - HCD or HPB Specific Data Elements
 - HIPAA Compliant Code Sets

Enrollment Process

- An enrollment process will be established to facilitate the process of creating a trading partner relationship between the District and its submitters
 - Identify submitter's needs
 - Clarify specific requirements (data elements, etc.)
 - Coordinate activities with EDI clearinghouses

- Trading Partner Agreements

- Testing of claim files and sign-off (clearance to transmit for actual payment)

- Internet Explorer for Web Browsing

- Test Files of Claims in ANSI X12N 837 format
 - Software for billing – vendor package or custom
 - Billing Service
 - Clearing House Agreement
