The purpose of this bulletin is to inform all participating providers that updates have been made to the Coordinated Care Benefits

### Coordinated Care Option 1

**General Physicians\*:** Allows two (2) office visits per any 30 day period to see a General Physician

**Example –** Member seen on January 1<sup>st</sup>, and seen again on January 15<sup>th</sup>. Member will not be allowed any additional visits until January 31<sup>st</sup>. This is a rolling 30 day cycle that calculates the number of office visits within any 30 day period.

1. This does not apply to pregnant women
2. This is for adults 21 years and older

**General Physician is defined as: Primary Care Physician, Family Practice Physician, General Practice Physician, Preventive Medicine Physician, Internal Medicine Physician, Public Health Physician, and Adult Primary Care Physician**
