Health Care District Offers Free, Walk-up Pediatric and Adult Pzzer COVID-19 Vaccines

The Health Care District of Palm Beach County reminds families that free, walk-up access to adult and pediatric doses of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccines are available at sites countywide and weekdays from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. outside the Health Care District's Lantana Clinic at 1250 Southwinds Drive where wait times are minimal. The Lantana site is open Monday, November 22 through Wednesday, November 24 and is closed for both Thanksgiving and Friday, November 26.

"Our mobile clinics are crisscrossing the county and are also conveniently parked outside our Lantana Clinic during the week for adults and children as young as five to be vaccinated against COVID-19," said Belma Andrić, MD, MPH, the Health Care District's Chief Medical Officer. "No appointment is necessary and boosters of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine are also available per <u>CDC guidelines</u> for those who are eligible."

Third doses are provided to eligible individuals 18 years and older who present their COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card showing they received two prior Pfizer doses.

The pediatric dose is one-third the strength of the vaccine formulated for individuals ages 12 and older and is authorized by the <u>FDA</u> and approved by the <u>U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention</u> (CDC) for children ages 5 through 11. According to the CDC, COVID-19 is the eighth-leading cause of death among this young age group. Children ages 5 through 17 must be with a parent or guardian to be vaccinated. To date, the Health Care District has provided nearly 223,000 COVID-19 vaccinations countywide. The Health Care District is partnering with the <u>School District of Palm Beach County</u> and will be at the following sites through the next two weeks:
